The SpLD Base is a resource centre where teachers and other educational professionals can view resources and academic literature as well as accessing guidance on teaching and learning strategies.

Key features of Outreach service:

- ❖ Advice and support to teachers of students with SpLD (dyslexia).
- ❖ Individual consultation sessions can be booked by Email, telephone or by post.
- ❖ Group training inset sessions at the SpLD Base advertised each term, for example, coping with dyslexia in the classroom, identification and inclusion strategies, etc.

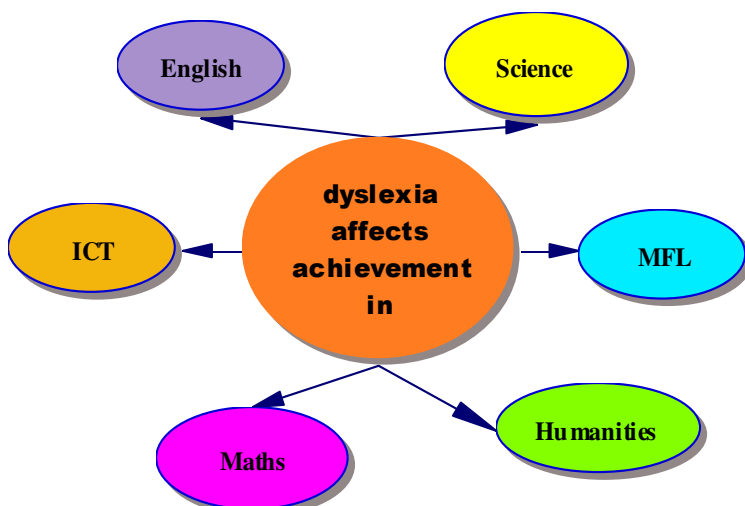
