Migration, Identity and Sovereignty.

Using the publicprofiler website, <u>http://gbnames.publicprofiler.org</u>, search your surname to obtain a distribution map for 1881 and 1998. Then **describe** and **explain** the differences in distribution between the maps. You can also search for the worldwide distribution of the surname as well using, <u>http://worldnames.publicprofiler.org</u>, and comment on the global spread as well. Including the three maps, this work should fill no more than 2 sides of A4.

Extension task: Chose an additional surname that interests you (a celebrity, other family name, mother's maiden name).

Coastal Landscapes and Change

For each of the following coastal landscape features:

- Salt marshes
- Sand dunes

Create a presentation (Prezi/PPT) - to last no longer than 10 minutes. Include the following:

- 1. Description
- 2. Explanation of formation
- 3. Plant succession
- 4. Challenges faced
- 5. Detailed UK case study


You should include relevant maps, diagrams and labelled photographs to illustrate your work.
