# **Microsoft Teams Training**

By next Monday, all key stage 3 students will have received training on Microsoft Teams. They will have been shown how to access the Office 365 suite of applications on all devices and have been given guidance on how to download and install the applications for free onto mobiles/tablets/laptops and desktop computers.

The main three applications were Teams, OneDrive and Outlook.

To enable the software, students will need to log in using their school email addresses and passwords. Once set up, students will be able to access live lessons as part of our contingency plan, if a year group bubble was required to self-isolate.

# **Virtual Assemblies**

This week saw another first for Barnwell school. Mr Launay broadcasted to all of Year 10 and 11 during lesson time. These online assemblies allowed Mr Launay to share key school and community messages to all students. The assemblies were recorded and will be made available to all of those that were unable to be in school.
