Entry Requirements: Grade 6 in English Lit / Lang at GCSE Level.

Course Description

A-level Law develops knowledge and understanding of the English Legal system.

The study of Law at A-level enables students to develop their analytical and critical thinking skills. Studying Law develops students' problem solving skills through the application of legal rules, together with an understanding of legal method and reasoning. These skills provide excellent preparation for those students who wish to progress to degree level study or pursue a wide range of careers. The Law affects everyone in society, without laws society is impossible.

This A Level Course will help you to understand the laws of England and Wales and why we have them, there will also be a focus on both Criminal and Tort Law.

Method(s) of Assessment

Paper 1: The Legal System and Criminal Law

Paper 2: Law Making and the Law of Tort

33.3% of overall A Level, 2 hour exam. 100 marks available.

Paper 3: The nature of Law and Human Rights Law/Contract Law

33.3% of overall A Level, 2 hour exam. 100 marks available.

Progression

With a qualification in Law, candidates can go on to higher education to study Law or Business Studies, or could work in the legal profession, management or local government.
