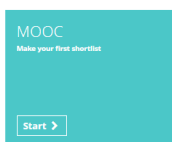

Once logged in, if you need help, just click on the Help tab at the top of the page and there are loads of self help guides for all areas of the Unifrog platform.

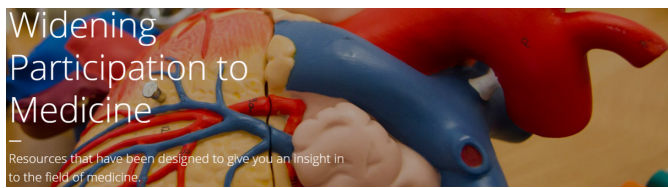


Widening Participation to Medicine

Medical School Virtual Work Experience

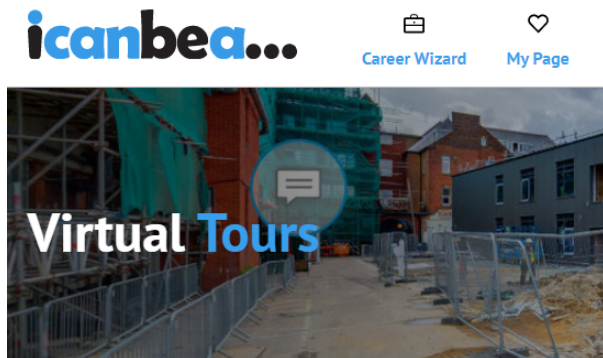
