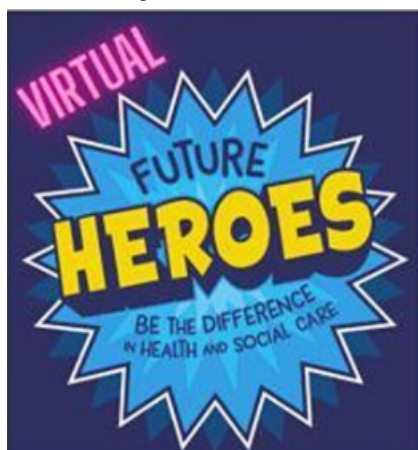

NHS - FUTURE HERO'S WEEK

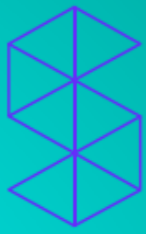

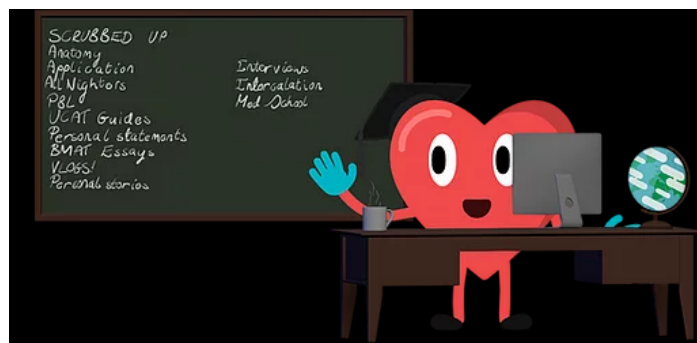

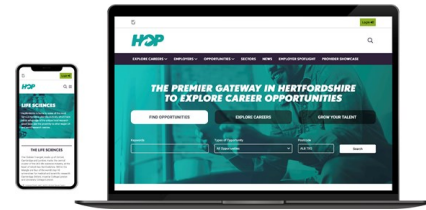
