Barnwell School - Sixth Form Entry Requirements



Our entry requirements are in place to ensure all students enrol on a programme of study in which they can be successful and achieve their full potential.

We treat all applications on an individual's basis, however these entry requirements provide a guidance for students regarding what is required for them to successfully make the next step to level 3 study.

To ensure students are on the most appropriate programme of study we use the average point score (APS) system. At Barnwell Sixth Form we take a student's best 6 grades and calculate an average from this. Information on how to calculate your 'best 6 APS' can be found on the following page. The table below shows the combination of subjects you should aspire to study, based on your best 6 APS.

- 1. Identify your best 6 GCSE point scores
- 2. Calculate the sum of these 6 GCSEs
- 3. Divide this number by 6
