Attendance is Everybody's Business

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Your information packs include information regarding the importance of attendance, legal responsibility, when children can have time off, illness and unauthorised holiday.

As parents/carers, you are <u>legally responsible</u> to ensure your child attends at least 95% of the school year.

There are over 100 days a year in which your child will not be in school due to public holiday.

Provider

- If your child is absent 5% of the school year they would miss **9.5** days of school which equals 57 lessons.
- If your child is absent 10% of the school year, they would miss 114 lessons.


Here at Barnwell, pupils with 95% attendance tend to achieve above their target grades. Pupils below 90% attendance significantly risk not achieving their target grades or achieving passes (grade 4) in Maths and English.

We encourage our Barnwell parents/carers to regularly support, promote and praise high levels of attendance as this will significantly support your child's desired outcomes.

What is the options process?

Tuesday 30 January

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Options Launch Event

Subject presentations about 14-16 courses available online from tomorrow morning.



Options Focus Week

Monday 5 February to Friday 9 February

Assemblies about new subjects, presented by the class teachers.



Year 9 Parents Evening

Wednesday 7 February and Thursday 15 February

An opportunity to discuss your progress and option choices with class teachers.



Options Conversations

Monday 12 February to Friday 1 March

All Year 9 Students will have a 1-1 conversation with a member of the senior team to ensure the choices made will allow the students to achieve success.



Deadline

Friday 8 March

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Are options first come, first served?

- No. We wait until after the options deadline before we start organising the Year 10 timetable and classes.
- We strongly recommend you take the time to research all of your options before submitting your final form.
- Do not hand your form in tonight.



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Do I need to choose reserve options?

- Yes. We cannot guarantee you will receive your first-choice options and so you do need to choose 'back-up' options.
- We may need to use your reserve options if a course is undersubscribed and cancelled, if a course is oversubscribed or if the combination of subjects you have chosen cannot be coordinated on your Year 10 timetable.



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Do I need to rank order my choices?

- Yes. The software we use to organise the option subjects for Year 10 prioritises your favourite subjects.
- We need you to rank your choices so we know which subjects you are most passionate about.



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Can I change my options if I don't like them?

- The deadline for changing options at the start of Year 10 is mid-September.
- Even then, we cannot guarantee that any changes will be possible.
- It is very important to research your options thoroughly before you submit your choices on March 8, as you will be studying your Key Stage 4 options for two years.



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When will I find out which options I have received?

- The options you have been allocated will be shared with you in June.
- If you have received a 'reserve' option, Mrs Collier will speak to you beforehand.



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What happens if I don't choose any options?

Mrs Collier chooses them for you.



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
- Check your pack for your Options form.
